Take my numeric numbers with a grain of salt, but they are pretty accurately describe how I feel about them, this is most of the manga that ive read and enjoyed somewhat, a lot o them I just read for the art thou so be warned. And ignore my spelling as well.

Dorohedoro 9.99999/10 - Probably my fav manga, cool fantasy, grungy, gory, every person has a interesting and usually very unique magic ability, combined with an interesting story with lots of good mysteries.

Berserk 8.5/10 – I think ive told you everything about this its very solid and a great fantasy story. Beware it will never be finished

Shigurui 8.5/10 – Set in feudal Japan, very complicated plot (you probably need to do some reading on how the feudal and honour system worked in Japan), but a very realistic samurai story with a tiny tiny bit of fantasy sprinkled in (its more like folk lore). But very cool sword fights that only last 2-3 seconds. Make sure you learn all the characters can be hard to follow.

Ping pong 8.2/10 – Follows two friends as they become intertwined in the world of professional ping pong. Pretty fun and light hearted with some awesome art and storytelling. It's a pretty typical sports manga but I think the characters make up for it.

Goodnight Punpun 8/10 – Super sad and tragic slice of life manga, that follows Punpun as he grows up from 4 years old to 20ish. Its pretty fun to watch Punpun's mind being warped and see how certain events has such massive impact on his psyche. Really great satisfying ending, and a lot of good recurring characters.

Parasyte 8/10 – You've read this. Still fucking great, kinda thought the last few chapters were weak but the premise and migi is just great fun, also has some cool monsters.

Blade of the Immortal 8/10 - An immortal samurai agrees to help a girl take revenge on the sword school that killed her family. Very cool premise with quite a few solid story arcs. The sword fights are great and it's just a really fun adventure to follow, nothing too special but it did really grab me when I finished it.

Liars Game 8/10 – Random people are forced into a game of logic and wits as they battle to win massive amounts of money. Got kinda old by the end but the first few games are great really smart and doesn't feel cheap at all, and a lot of "ohhh I get it" moments.

Ichi the Killer 7.5/10 – HOLY FUCK so bloody gory like a dude gets his dick deep fried. Despite all the gore it's pretty a pretty good cat and mouse story with some fucked up characters with surprisingly a lot of depth. I don't normally read mangas in one sitting but I finished this in one day, so I guess that says something.

All you Need is Kill 7.5/10 – Edge of Tomorrow (Live Die Repeat) is based off this, just a really short little manga with a very strong idea, kinda wish it was a little bit longer some things aren't explained as well as I would like.
